

THE SOUTHEND BOROUGH COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021

THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED) (NEWLANDS ROAD & SALISBURY AVENUE – JUNCTION) AMENDMENT NO.28 ORDER 2023

Southend-on-Sea City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 122 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the 1984 Act”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to the liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (as amended) (To be known as ‘The 2021 Order’) shall have effect as though;
 - (i) To introduce junction protection restrictions - No Waiting at Any Time and No Loading and Unloading at Any Time – for a distance of 10m on both sides; at the junction of Newlands Road and Salisbury Avenue.
2. The effect of this Order is to (this article is an explanatory note this is not part of the Order) introduce restrictions at the junction of Newlands Road and Salisbury Avenue.
3. The remainder of The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This Order shall come into effect on the 21st day of September 2023 and may be cited as “The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021. The Southend-on-Sea City Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Newlands Road & Salisbury Avenue - Junction) Amendment No.28 Order 2023.”
