**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)** 

**Notice is hereby given** that the Southend-on-Sea City Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering & exiting Eastwoodbury Close (no access to residents is regrettable during these works. However, where possible, the utility provider will try to accommodate access where necessary and in the event of an emergency)

The closure is scheduled to commence from 08:00 on the 18<sup>th of</sup> June 2024 until 17:00 on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting. The utility provider will endeavour to shorten the duration of these works where permitted but is dependent on many factors; including but not limited to other contractors and weather.

The Order will come into effect on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and may continue for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst City Fibre permanent reinstatement works takes place.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the **TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016** 

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004
