SECTION 14(2)(a) NOTICE (TTN2258)

- 1. Southend-on-Sea City Council hereby gives notice that to facilitate essential carriageway maintenance works, they have imposed a temporary prohibition of traffic, parking, waiting, loading & unloading, on Southbourne Grove.
- 2. Whilst this Notice is in operation, all vehicles will be prohibited from:
- a) Traffic, parking, waiting, loading and unloading on Southbourne Grove on both sides of the road, from its junction with Clatterfield Gardens to its junction with Eastwood Lane South.
- 3. Nothing in the Notice will apply to:
- (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public utility vehicle:
- (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer;
- (c) any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police and Coastguard/RNLI purposes.
- 4. These prohibitions or restrictions will come into effect on 12th June 2024 for 3 days. This notice will remain in force for 5 days to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works.
- 5. The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
