

**THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS) (CONSOLIDATION OF MOVING TRAFFIC AND SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2006 (AS AMENDMED) (AMENDMENT NO.1) ORDER 2024**

The Southend-on-Sea City Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 124 (and part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and of all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Southend-on-Sea Borough Council (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Moving Traffic and Speed Limit) Order 2006 (as amended) ("the 2006 Order"), is hereby further amended by:

The addition of the following to Article 3:

"Bullion Vehicle" means a security liveried motor vehicle, which is specifically adapted for the secure carriage of precious metals, cash or other valuables.

"Public Service Vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a tramcar) which—

- (a) being a vehicle adapted to carry more than eight passengers, is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward; or
- (b) being a vehicle not so adapted, is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward at separate fares in the course of a business of carrying passengers.

The addition of the following to Article 13:

- (e) with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
- (f) for Fire brigade, Police or Ambulance purpose;
- (g) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The addition of the items in Schedule 1 to this Order as though they were in Schedule 3 to the 2006 Order.

The addition of the items in Schedule 2 to this Order as though they were in Schedule 9 to the 2006 Order.

The revocation of the items in Schedule 1 to the 2006 Order numbered 3562, 3611, 3612, 3613, 3616, 3618, 3619, 3622, 3624, 3625 and 3627.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 18th June 2024 and may be cited as The Southend-on-Sea City Council (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Moving Traffic and Speed Limit) Order 2006 (as amended) (Amendment No.1) Order 2024
3. Other than the Amendments of this Order, the Southend-on-Sea Borough Council (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Moving Traffic and Speed Limit) Order 2006 (as amended) remains in full force and effect.
