## SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN ACCESS) (TTN2308) NOTICE 2024 (FOOTPATH 177 – SUTTON ROAD TO JOURNEYMANS WAY)

Notice is given that the Southend-on-Sea City Council under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, have imposed an emergency temporary prohibition of pedestrian access. The effects of this Notice will be as follows:

- 1. Southend-on-Sea City Council will be carrying out emergency work due to decayed steps. Whilst this Notice is in operation pedestrians will be prohibited from accessing, footpath 177 between Sutton Road and Journeymans Way.
- 2. These prohibitions or restrictions will come into effect on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2024 and will continue in force for 21 days. The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.
- 3. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a penalty charge notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004. This Notice will not apply to:
  - a) Anything done at the direction of a police officer in uniform, or a police community support officer (PCSO);
  - b) Any vehicle or person in connection to the police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - c) Any official vehicle or person in connection with the works.
